The Wines

Jester Sangiovese Rosé McLaren Vale

Rich, juicy and plenty of mouth-coating flavour. The palate displays layers of red berry fruit which combine with mineral notes, leading to a long dry finish.

Jester Shiraz McLaren Vale

Rich and full bodied on the palate with flavours of blackcurrant, anise and mixed spice. The palate is multilayered and finishes with supple tannins.

Reiver Shiraz Barossa Valley

Hints of liquorice, cherry liquor and earthy leathery notes. The palate is dense whilst showing lively hints of truffle, espresso and a mineral finish.

G.A.M. Shiraz McLaren Vale

A dense ruby/purple colour with layers of dried spice, coffee and blackcurrant. The wine displays fullness, freshness and seamless oak integration.

Savitar Shiraz McLaren Vale

The nose shows masses of smoky cedar, plums, cherry and dried herbs. Full bodied and opulent yet managing to maintain supple, refined tannin and a clean, fresh finish.

Jester Cabernet Sauvignon McLaren Vale

A lifted and herbaceous nose with hints of ripe plums and nutmeg. The wine exhibits fresh rich berry fruits, soft tannins, savoury complexity and a mid palate depth.

Serpico Cabernet Sauvignon McLaren Vale

Made using grapes dried in the Amarone winemaking method. Earth and cedary spice with hints of pudding and coffee beans. The palate is complex with richness and savoury tannins. This distinguished wine can be drunk on release.
