“The 2006 Shiraz Savitar was aged in 100% new oak, predominantly French. Purple-colored, the aromatics are a bit reticent initially, but soon scents of toasty oak, tar, licorice, scorced earth and blueberry emerge. This leads to a wine which is more structured and less opulent than it’s peers. It will evolve for a minimum of 8-10 years and drink well through to 2040”.
